ORDER SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

I Subject of the order

- The subject of the order as part of this request for proposal is the conduction of lectures and specialist classes in English within Work Package WP7 of the project titled: "CONCERT-European Joint Programme for the Integration of Radiation Protection Research", financed under the HORIZON 2020 programme.
- 2. Order accomplishment terms and conditions:
 - 1) Scope of lectures and classes:

The classes will be held on March 19-20 2020 and will encompass: 4 hours of lectures and 2 hours of practical classes in the following scope:

- a) hazards related to the presence of radon,
- b) concentration measurements of radon and radon derivatives in the air and water,
- c) calculating uncertainty and detection thresholds in nuclear physics,
- d) classification of contaminated areas based on a statistical analysis of the results of environmental monitoring.
- 2) Apart from the remuneration, the Contractor shall be entitled to a reimbursement of travel costs necessary to perform the subject of the order, to an amount no greater than 450 Euro. The reimbursement will be made based on a balance sheet of incurred costs prepared by the Contractor as well as on enclosed copies of documents confirming that the costs were incurred.
- 3) The lecture will be held at the Central Mining Institute in Katowice, Plac Gwarków 1, 40-166 Katowice, in the conference room of the Silesian Centre of Environmental Radioactivity.

3. Requirements:

- a. European Union member state citizenship, excluding Polish citizenship,
- b. experience in the use of high-resolution gamma-ray spectroscopy, in alpha-, beta- and gamma-ray spectroscopy, in radon measurements, at least 5 years,
- c. doctor's degree in natural science,
- d. experience as university lecturer, at least 5 years,
- e. at least 10 publications concerning measurements used in nuclear physics and/or monitoring the presence of radioactive substances in the environment.

4. Payment terms:

Remuneration shall be paid via bank transfer after the performance of the contract, after 14 days following the submission of a report of acceptance confirming the performance of tasks by the Contractor, together with a receipt.

Monitoring strategies applied in NORM involving industries

– evaluation of occupational exposure and environmental impact
is part of the CONCERT project.
